Boardroom tables have been the bedrock of our company for the past 22 years. Our first table was produced for Arbutnot Latham in 1983 with Officescape and one of our more recent tables is shown here.

This table was designed by Foster & Partners for HSBC HQ in Canary Wharf.

Below is a selection of our boardroom tables.



AELTCC: Crown and 1/4 cut, with service line and tennis ball inlays in kingwood and quilted maple. Integrated AV, power and data through table top.



Barclays Bank HQ: In curly maple, figured maple and leather with hinged flaps in curly maple for access to power and data. The inlay is polished stainless steel.



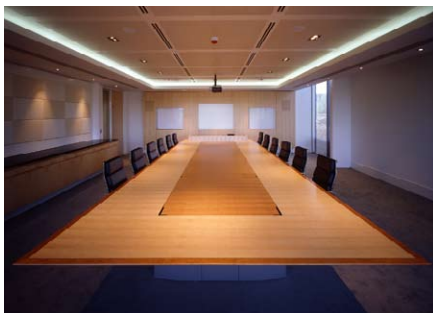
British Embassy, Paris: In burr walnut veneer and solid walnut. Chairs in solid walnut and horsehair fabric. This was a difficult brief as the table and chairs had to sit in a Grade I listed interior, yet evoke a modern feel.

This was achieved by using traditional materials with clean lines and subtle detailing.



Cinven: In European oak with white inlay detail to the top and edge, boat-shaped base in European oak.

The table splits into 2 halves so it can be moved to the sides of the room, enabling the room to be set up for seminars using tables with our quick release Clipper base.



Cisco Systems: AV table in figured maple, American cherry and powder coated bases.

The table has a credenza and lectern at one end, which houses all of the AV equipment and room controls, which are touch screen actuated.



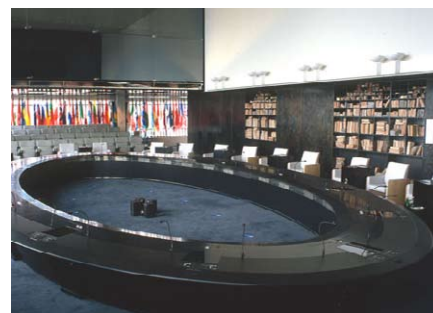
CitiBank: Horseshoe shaped table in weathered sycamore. Designed to match a lighting detail and accommodate both board meetings and V/C.

The table has integral electronic rise and fall facilities for power, data and audio/visual functions.



Enron: In burr walnut, weathered sycamore, solid walnut and powder coated boat shaped bases.

The table is designed to house power and data with cables running up through the bases and along trunking to terminate in boxes on the underside of the table top. Access is via hinged flaps in the table top.



European Bank for Reconstruction and Development: Oval conference table in black matt polyester, black leather and stainless steel.

This table is designed to house audio, data, and power. The monitors are for receiving language script, which is translated by PA's who sit behind the various delegates.



HSBC: Boardroom table designed by Foster & Partners for HSBC HQ in Canary Wharf. The table is made from pommelle and crotch mahogany. All cabling is stored in the base and runs up to power boxes to the underside of the top.

London Stock Exchange: Oval table in straight grain figured walnut, burr walnut and leather.

The waterfall edge is wrapped in leather for a soft feel and the microphones are set into the burr walnut inner band.



Merrill Lynch HQ: In American walnut and burr walnut with concealed access lids to power, data and microphones.



Private Bank: Boardroom table in straight grain walnut and burr walnut with wenge inlay. Straight grain walnut is laid in herringbone style, slip matched from the centre of the table.



Rabobank: Hinged scissor table in figured maple and brushed stainless steel. Power and data sockets are housed to the underside of the table top and accessed through hinged flaps in the top.

The table is designed to be used for AV and boardroom meetings and therefore can be opened and closed to accommodate this facility.
