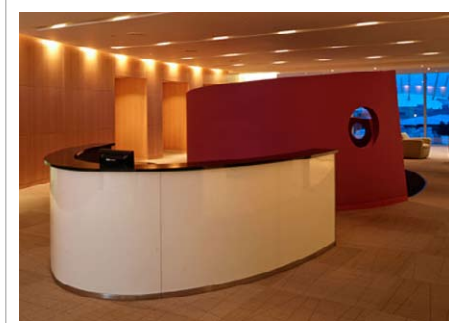

**Clifford Chance:** Nero assoluto granite top, white back painted curved glass fronts and polished stainless steel details.



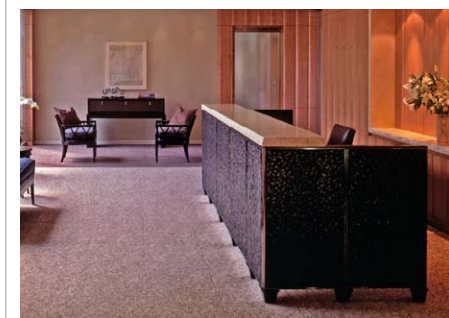
**Ernst & Young:** Polyester lacquer front, Swiss pear top, brushed stainless steel plinth and vase. Also with a walk-in coffee point in polyester.



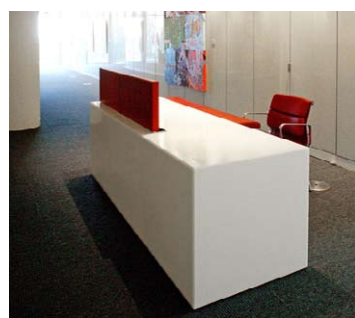
**Gemini:** In Pear wood with frosted glass center top and stainless steel supports.



**IBM:** Brushed stainless steel, maple and nero assoluto granite.



**Moore Capital:** Carved walnut front panel, stainless steel base, stainless steel inlays and crema marfil marble counter top.



**One Tower Place:** Full gloss polyester lacquer with red leather upstand and arm rest.



**Reuters:** Nero assoluto granite counter top, glass and AC lacquer front panels, with stainless steel details and plinth.



**Royal Society:** American cherry front panel with sycamore inlay detail, lights in copper with verdigris finish and handmade glass bowls.



**Standard Life:** Weathered sycamore front panel. Glass counter top and supports, and bronze light baffle. Glass supports are lit with fibre optic lighting.
